

Summer Camp 2008 Membership Agreement

1. I understand that all summer camp memberships are based on weekly sessions. I have chosen from 1 to 5 days per week, either half or full day as I indicated on registration form.

2. Payment Plan:

- 25% of total cost for all sessions you register for is due upon registration and it is not refundable.
- Balance is due on or before June 30, 2008 (first day of the camp)
- Discount may be applied if paying in full for four (4) or eight (8) full weeks before June 9, 2008.
- There is \$25 handling charge on any returned checks.
- There is \$25 registration and accident medical insurance fee and is required by all participants – **no exceptions!** Your policy is a secondary policy, which is valid only if you are a fully paid member.

3. I understand that a written notice of any cancellation must be given at least two (2) weeks prior the beginning of the session you are registered for. If notification is not given, the student's legal guardian remains responsible for the payments.

4. **Memberships are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be sold.** I understand that once the session begins I may not cancel prior to the expiration of my membership time, and the failure to partake of the provided facilities for any reason will not release me from paying full cost of membership.

5. I understand that if under the terms of this Membership Agreement there is a breach of contract due to non-payment, Arena Gymnastics, Inc. reserves the right to turn your account over to an attorney or other agency for collection. Members will be charged for all collection costs incurred, including reasonable attorney's fee.

6. I understand that Arena Gymnastics, Inc., shall not be responsible for the inability to provide facilities of service due to force majeure, fire, accident, extraordinary maintenance or other causes which could not reasonably be prevented.

7. I hereby state that the above named applicant has no physical or mental conditions or limitations that prohibit full vigorous participation in gymnastics. I also understand that it is my responsibility to inform Arena Gymnastics, Inc., in writing of any physical or mental conditions or limitations that Arena's Staff should be aware of in dealing with enrollee during activities and/or in case of an emergency. Arena's Staff accepts no liability for failure to inform them of any conditions or limitations.

8. I am fully aware of and understand the risk, including the risk of catastrophic injury, paralysis, or even death, as well as other losses associated with participation in gymnastics program. I also understand the above conditions and risk, and enroll the above named person at his/her/my own risk. I hereby indemnify and hold Arena Gymnastics, Inc., its officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives, successors, and/or assigns, harmless from and against any and all risk and liability assumed by or on behalf of the student, excepting herefrom acts of gross negligence by Arena's Staff.

9. I understand that Arena Gymnastics, Inc., is not liable for personal injury to the applicant's family members and their guests as they use the facility at their own risk.

10. Camp rules and regulations:

- All children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when entering the building during morning drop off.
- For safety of your child during pick up, your child will be released to AUTHORIZED PERSONS ONLY. If your child is to be picked up by someone else than parents (guardians) listed on Registration Form, a note will be required indicating the name of person that your child is to be released to. If there are special circumstances, Arena Gymnastics must be notified in writing at the time of registration.
- All children should eat high-energy breakfast; there will be no breakfast served in the gym. Each camper should bring a lunch box labeled with the name. Snacks and beverages are available in our vending machines.
- **No one** is allowed in the gym part of the facility without supervision by the staff member.
- Students may wear no jewelry of any type while participating in a class.
- Girls must wear leotards or shorts and tee shirt; be in bare feet or wear white athletic socks.
- Boys must wear gym shorts and tee shirt; be in bare feet or wear white athletic socks.
- Long hair must be tied back.
- Clothing not being worn during class must be stored in cubby holes.
- No valuables should be brought into the school. We are not responsible for any articles being misplaced, lost or stolen.
- Any children, while on the premises, who are not participating in a camp program must remain in the waiting area, and must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian when using restroom facilities.
- Arena Gymnastics, Inc., reserves the right to make changes to its Rules and Regulations whenever it is necessary, for safety purpose or other good cause. Any changes to the rules will be posted in the gym, and it is your responsibility to check on such changes.
- Arena Gymnastics, Inc., reserves the right to revoke membership of any member in case of disruptive behavior or a delinquent attitude of a member or his/her family, or friends while on the premises or surrounding grounds.

In the event that parent or legal guardian of minor is unable to be reached in case of emergency, I hereby authorize and direct Arena's Staff to contact the physician listed on the Registration form.
